The Collis Curve 'Baby' (Green Top) has a smaller brush head for easy manipulation by parents as they brush their children's teeth. Collis Curve's 'on track' backwards and forwards brushing technique makes the task easy. Use at appearance of first tooth.



The Collis Curve Junior brush (Blue Top) has a small head for easy manipulation in the confined spaces of the young patient's mouth. Start using at the appearance of the first molar, usually at 6 years old. It is recommended to assist children in brushing until at least that age.
